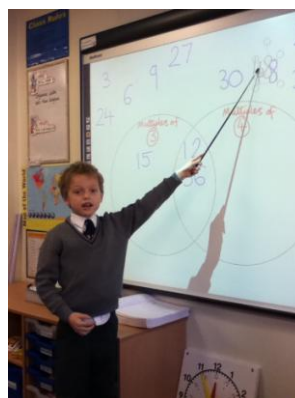
On the Pick Pack Pock
